

Types of Trauma



ACUTE

An isolated event such as being the victim of a crime, surviving a natural disaster or serious accident.



CHRONIC

Repeated or prolonged trauma. Living through an ongoing situation such as experiencing domestic violence, slavery, or war.



COMPLEX

Experiencing multi-layered traumatic experiences such as sexual assault, neglect, abuse, poverty, and more....

ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCE (ACEs)

Caterpillar (Larva) 2nd Stage of Metamorphosis)

- Insulted and belittled by my father
- Enduring physical abuse preventing me from sitting or going to school
- Experiencing homelessness
- Dealing with roaches and living in unsanitary conditions
- Facing rejection
- Confronting racism
- Lacking a sense of belonging
- Sexually Exploited as a Teenager

- Experiencing invisibility, lack of affection, and rejection
- Feeling disconnected
- Insufficient food supply
- Parents' divorce
- Turning to alcohol as a coping mechanism
- Battling depression
- Struggling with mental health issues


DEFY THE ODDS?

EFFECTS OF UNHEALED TRAUMA The Person Who Came Looking For Resources...

- Resistant to positive change
- Suffering through codependency in relationships
- Difficulty asserting boundaries
- Craving external validation
- Fear of being abandoned
- Innate feelings of shame
- Tolerating abusive behaviors from others
- Low sense of self-worth and low self-esteem
