VIVITROL PROGRAM

- WHAT IS VIVITROL: VIVITROL IS USED AS PART OF A TREATMENT PROGRAM FOR DRUG OR ALCOHOL DEPENDENCE. VIVITROL IS USED TO PREVENT
 RELAPSE IN PEOPLE WHO BECAME DEPENDENT ON OPIOID MEDICINE AND THEN STOPPED USING IT. VIVITROL IS AN EXTENDED RELEASE
 FORMULATION OF NALTREXONE, WHICH IS AN OPIOID RECEPTOR ANTAGONIST.
- VIVITROL IS RECOMMENDED TO BE TAKEN 1X EVERY 28 DAYS FOR 11 MONTHS.
- INDIVIDUALS NEEDS TO BE CLEAN OF DRUGS AND ALCOHOL BETWEEN 7 TO 14 DAYS, IF NOT AN INDIVIDUAL COULD START AN OVERDOES UPON THEMSELVES
- VIVITROL REMOVES THE CRAVINGS FOR BOTH ALCOHOL AND THE OPIOID DRUG
- REMOVES THE OPIOID DRUG
- VIVITROL IS COVERED BY MOST STATE INSURANCE. VIVITROL ALSO CAN BE COVERED AT 90% WITH COMMERCIAL INSURANCES AND CASH PAYMENTS
- VIVITROL CO-PAY PROGRAM
- VIVITROL DOES HAVE SIDE AFFECTS AND COMMON EFFECTS

OPERATION OF VIVITROL PROCESS:

- INTERVIEW NEW BOOKINGS (INDIVIDUALS THAT HAVE BEEN ARRESTED FOR POSSESSION OF DRUGS, OR ANY DRUG RELATED CHARGE
- ASK WHAT DRUG WAS LAST USED PRIOR TO RELEASE, WHAT IS THERE DRUG OF CHOICE, ANY OTHER DRUGS USED PRIOR TO INCARCERATION, FOLLOW UP
 WITH PROBATION OFFICERS, AND ATTORNEYS TO LEARN ABOUT INDIVIDUALS HISTORY OF DRUGS
- LOOKING FOR OPIOID DRUG USED
- COMPLETE A CRISIS PLAN, AMERICAN SOCIETY OF ADDICTION MEDICINE (ASAM) ASSESSMENT, QUESTIONNAIRE. MONTHLY SURVEY FOR THE STATE FOR
 VIVITROL FUNDING
- VERIFY IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS A SHEBOYGAN COUNTY (TO QUALIFY)
- ENROLL IN PROGRAM (6 MONTH PROGRAM, WHICH IS FOLLOW UP CONTACT, SETTING UP COUNSELING AND TREATMENT SERVICES, AND PROVIDING OTHER RESOURCES THAT INDIVIDUALS COULD BENEFIT FROM: SUPPORT GROUPS, EMPLOYMENT AND HOUSING ASSISTANCE, SUPPORT FOLLOW UP IN THE COMMUNITY, AND ANY OTHER ASSISTANCE THEY MAY NEED (AGENCY CONTACTS, ADDRESSES, BUSINESS HOURS, AND QUESTIONS
- EDUCATIONAL GROUPS (VIVITROL, NARCAN, FENTANYL TEST STRIPS, ANGER RESOLUTION, THINKING 4 CHANGES (SKILLS TOOL SETS)
- PROVIDE CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

- EDUCATION IS KEY: WE MUST FIRST EDUCATE OUR COMMUNITY IN HOW TO END POVERTY BY INFORMING AND EXPLAINING HOW TO LIVE A MEANINGFUL LIFE:

ADVOCACY

- EDUCATE YOURSELF: UNDERSTAND THE ISSUES AFFECTING YOUR COMMUNITY AND HOW YOU CAN USE YOUR SKILLS AND RESOURCES TO HELP.
- ENGAGE IN CIVIC ACTIVITIES: PARTICIPATE IN ACTIVITIES THAT ENCOURAGE COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT ON ISSUES OF PUBLIC CONCERN.
- ORGANIZE AWARENESS EMPLOYMENT MEETINGS AND COMMUNITY MEETINGS: COMMUNICATE WITH LOCAL POLICYMAKERS TO INFLUENCE CHANGE AND BUILD CONNECTIONS.
- PLAN YOUR GOALS: USE DATA TO GUIDE DECISION-MAKING AND CREATE A SUCCESSFUL COMMUNITY INITIATIVE.
- FOLLOW UP ON CLIENTS REGULARLY
