RURAL, CONSERVATIVE COMMUNITY ON EAST SIDE OF STATE

LOCATED BETWEEN MILWAUKEE AND GREEN BAY, ON LAKE MICHIGAN

POPULATION: 81,464 (21ST LARGEST COUNTY OUT OF 72)

PRESCRIPTION OPIATES FLOODED IN THE COMMUNITY FOR A LONG PERIOD OF TIME CONTRIBUTING TO A COMMUNITY ALREADY STRUGGLING WITH SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER

COMMUNITY THAT HISTORICALLY HAD A DEFICIT IN AODA/MH SERVICES

MANITOWOC COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES OFFERED MINIMAL SERVICES

COMMUNITY HAD A 12 BED RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTER THAT MOST WERE REFERRED TO. RESTRICTIONS CAUSED A LIMITATION TO ACCESS



2016

- MANITOWOC COUNTY APPLIED FOR AND AWARDED GRANT (TREATMENT ALTERNATIVES AND DIVERSION/TAD GRANT) TO DEVELOP AND START AN ADULT DRUG TREATMENT COURT.
- COMMUNITY "APPREHENSIVE" ABOUT THE IDEA OF RECOVERY AND THE DRUG COURT PROGRAM AS BEING A WORTHWHILE PROGRAM.

2017

- DEVELOPMENT OF MANITOWOC COUNTY DRUG COURT PROGRAM BEGAN (FEBRUARY).
- FLOODED COMMUNITY WITH INFORMATION REGARDING DRUG COURT PROGRAM / ADDICTION / RECOVERY
- SPEAKING AT EVERY COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION THAT WOULD ALLOW
- ASKED (BEGGED) INDIVIDUALS TO ATTEND DRUG COURT SESSIONS
- IDENTIFIED COMMUNITY CHAMPIONS
- MANITOWOC COUNTY HSD STARTS INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT AND AFTERCARE GROUPS
- DRUG COURT FIRST SESSION IN SEPTEMBER 2017

- **2018**
 - CONTINUED COMMUNITY ADVOCACY AND EDUCATION
 - CHRISTMA RUSCH DEVELOPED AND STARTED LRCC
 - A CHURCH OPENED SOBER LIVING HOMES FOR MEN AND WOMEN
 - DRUG COURT PROGRAM GROWING IN SUPPORT EXPONENTIALLY
 - DRUG COURT CELEBRATES FIRST "GRADUATION"; CHANNEL 2 NEWS COVERED EVENT
 - ► FOCUSED ATTENTION ON IDENTIFYING COMMUNITY EMPLOYERS TO HIRE ON DRUG COURT PARTICIPANTS/PEOPLE IN RECOVERY.
 - MULTIPLE EMPLOYERS THROUGHOUT THE COMMUNITY AGREED TO BRING ON OUR POPULATION AND TO WORK AROUND THEIR TREATMENT AND MEETING SCHEDULE

- **2019**
 - ► CONTINUED COMMUNITY

 ADVOCACY AND EDUCATION
 - ► CONTINUED BUILDING ON ADDITIONAL EMPLOYERS WILLING TO HIRE OUR POPULATION GIVEN THEIR UNIQUE SITUATIONS
 - ► ATTEMPTED TO BRING ON LANDLORDS/HOUSING PROVIDERS (WHICH WAS NOT MET WITH SUCCESS)
 - DRUG COURT PROGRAM CONTINUED TO GROW IN COMMUNITY SUPPORT
 - ► LRCC CONTINUED TO GROW IN COMMUNITY SUPPORT AND BECAME A "KNOWN COMMODITY"

2020

- •LRCC ABSORBED MARCO SERVICES, MANITOWOC'S RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROVIDER, ALONG WITH ALL OF ITS PROPERTY'S.
- •LRCC TRANSITIONED TREATMENT HOME TO SUPPORTIVE LIVING (HORIZON'S), CREATING 24/7 STAFFED SOBER LIVING FOR INDIVIDUALS IN EARLY RECOVERY
- •LRCC TRANSITIONED 2 OTHER PROPERTIES FOR SOBER LIVING (1 MALE/1 FEMALE)
- CORE TREATMENT SERVICES OPENED, OFFERING RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT SERVICES

2021

- LRCC ABSORBED A RECOVERY COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION, WIRCO. LRCC BEGAN OFFERING SERVICES IN SHEBOYGAN
- RESTORATION HOUSE OPENED IT'S FIRST SOBER LIVING HOME

HISTORY OF THE TRANSITION

2022

- •LRCC WAS NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED THROUGH THE "MOBILIZE RECOVERY" EVENT AS A MODEL TO BE FOLLOWED.
- LRCC HAD SUCCESSFULLY ASSISTED 50 FAMILIES IN THE REUNIFICATION PROCESS
- •LRCC BEGAN A PARTENRSHIP WITH ROGERS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH THROUGH GROUP FACILITATION AND PRESENTATIONS

2023

- LRCC AWARDED TWO GRANTS THAT RENOVATED ONE RECOVERY HOME AND PURCHASED BUILDING FOR A NEW RECOVERY DROP-IN CENTER.
- •LRCC PURCHASED NEW BUILDING AND BEGAN RENOVATIONS TO CREATE A NEW RECOVERY DROP-IN CENTER



WHAT IS THE FORMULA?

- EVERY COMMUNITY WILL BE DIFFERENT, BUT THE BASIC FORMULA IS SIMPLE AND CAN BE REPLICATABLE REGARDLESS OF THE COMMUNITY DIFFERENCES.
- "THE WAY TO GET STARTED IS TO QUIT TALKING AND BEGIN DOING"-WALT DISNEY
- EVERYTHING STARTS WITH THE PEOPLE!!!!
 - FIND YOUR CHAMPIONS (RECOVERY COMMUNITY/FAITH BASED ORGANIZATIONS)
 - IDENTIFY THE COMMUNITY DEFICITS
 - BUILD SUPPORT/MOMENTUM/CREATE NOISE
 - SUCCESSES HAVE TO BE DISPLAYED!!!!
 - STATISTICS ARE MEANINGLESS-PERSONALIZE THE MESSAGE
 - FOCUS ON COLLABORATION-NOT COMPETITION
 - ROADBLOCKS AND BARRIERS ARE **NOT** STOP SIGNS
 - THE SUCCESS OF OUR MODEL IS BASED OFF OF THE INTEGRATION AND EMPOWERMENT OF THOSE WITH LIVED EXPERIENCE

RECOVERY ORIENTED COMMUNITY (ROC)¹

PURPOSE OF A ROC

- INSPIRE PUBLIC INTEREST IN WHOLE HEALTH AND OPEN DIALOGUES ABOUT HOW COMMUNITIES PLAY AN INTEGRAL ROLE IN THE RECOVERY OF ITS RESIDENTS.
- RAISE AWARENESS OF RESOURCES AND ENCOURAGE RESIDENTS TO ENGAGE IN CARE AS SOON AS THE NEED IS IDENTIFIED SO RECOVERY CAN BEGIN, HOPE IS INSPIRED, AND TRAGEDIES ARE AVOIDED.

QUALITIES OF A ROC

- AIM TO INSPIRE PUBLIC INTEREST AND OPEN DIALOGUES ABOUT RECOVERY.
- RAISE AWARENESS OF THE NEED FOR RECOVERY SUPPORTS IN OUR COMMUNITIES.
- CREATE A CULTURE WHEREIN ALL RESIDENTS FEEL SUPPORTED BY THEIR COMMUNITY AND NEIGHBORS AND FEEL FREE TO SEEK TREATMENT WITHOUT FEAR OF STIGMA AND PROMOTING AWARENESS THAT THERE CAN BE NO DISCOURSE ON "HEALTH" WITHOUT CONSIDERATION OF "WHOLE HEALTH" AND ENCOURAGING RESIDENTS OF ALL AGES TO BE MINDFUL OF THEIR WHOLE HEALTH AND ASK FOR HELP WHEN NEEDED.
- •LOCAL RESOURCES ARE AVAILABLE TO PROMOTE HOPE AND RECOVERY WITHIN THE COMMUNITY SO NO ONE RESIDENT NEEDS TO SUFFER ALONE OR FEEL HOPELESS.

RECOVERY ORIENTED SYSTEM OF CARE (ROSC)²

DEFINITION OF ROSC

•A COORDINATED NETWORK OF COMMMUNITY BASED SERVICES AND SUPPORTS THAT IS PERSON CENTERED AND BUILDS ON THE STRENGTHS AND RESILIENCIES OF INDIVIDUALS, FAMILIES AND COMMUNITIES TO ACHIEVE ABSTINENCE AND IMPROVED HEALTH, WELLNESS AND QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THOSE WITH OR AT RISK OA ALCOHOL OR DRUG PROBLEMS (SAMHSA)

FOCUS OF ROSC

- CREATE A SYSTEM OF CARE OR STRUCTURE WITH ALL THE RESOURCES NEEDED IN COMMUNITIES ACROSS THE ENTIRE SERVICE SPECTRUM FROM PREVENTION THROUGH TREATMENT, CONTINUING CARE AND LONG-TERM RECOVERY
- CREATE PARTNERSHIPS WITH OTHER DISCIPLINES, SUCH AS MENTAL HEALTH AND PRIMARY CARE, THUS OFFERING COMPREHENSIVE CARE AND SUPPORTS THAT FOCUS ON THE WHOLE PERSON WITHIN COMMUNITY.

17 Elements of ROSC

- Systems anchored in the community
- Continuity of Care

- Partnership-consulting relationships
- Strength based

- Adequately and flexibly financed







1. Precontemplation

Definition:

Not yet considering change or is unwilling or unable to change.

Primary Task:

Raising Awareness

2. Contemplation

Definition:

Sees the possibility of change but is ambivalent and uncertain.

Primary Task:

Resolving ambivalence/ Helping to choose change

6. Recurrence

Definition:

Experienced a recurrence of the symptoms.

Primary Task:

Cope with consequences and determine what to do next

5. Maintenance

Definition:

Has achieved the goals and is working to maintain change.

Primary Task:

Develop new skills for maintaining recovery

Stages of Change: Primary Tasks

4. Action

Definition:

Taking steps toward change but hasn't stabilized in the process.

Primary Task:

Help implement change strategies and learn to eliminate potential relapses

3. Determination

Definition:

Committed to changing. Still considering what to do.

Primary Task:

Help identify appropriate change strategies


